## MOTION OF THE HAMILTON SECURITIES GROUP, INC., AND HAMILTON SECURITIES ADVISORY SERVICES, INC., TO UNSEAL RECORD

Petitioner, Susan Gaffney, in her official capacity as
Inspector General, United States Department of Housing and Urban
Development, by her undersigned counsel, hereby submits this
response to the Motion of the Hamilton Securities Group, Inc.,
and Hamilton Securities Advisory Services, Inc. (collectively
"Hamilton"), to Unseal Record.

At the commencement of this proceeding, the Petitioner moved that the record herein be sealed upon the grounds that sealing the record would assist in the preservation of the seal on a related <u>qui tam</u> complaint, would help to protect the confidentiality of a pending law enforcement investigation, and would protect Hamilton from adverse publicity concerning the ongoing investigation. Given that the issues in this proceeding

have been briefed without disclosing the contents of the sealed qui tam action, other than its existence and the fact that Respondents are named defendants, thus greatly reducing risk of compromising the seal on the related qui tam complaint or impairing the related investigation, and that Hamilton has requested that the matter be unsealed, thereby waiving all future claims associated with adverse publicity, Petitioner does not object to unsealing Misc. No. 98-92 (SS), at this time.

Petitioner hereby reserves the right in the future to seek an in camera filing with respect to any particular pleading or document it provides the Court that may contain confidential investigative information or details concerning the qui tam action.
