Under the Freedom of Information Act, please provide us with the transcripts of the two presentations that were given. Please do not attempt to justify withholding this information under section 821 of Public Law 104-201, as in that law a "proposal" is defined as "any proposal. . . submitted by a contractor in response to the requirements of a solicitation for a competitive proposal." Since these transcripts were created by HUD and not "submitted by a contractor" (emphasis added), the exemption should not apply in this case.
