Bids Submitted on the Two Most Recent Note Sales

Dear Ms. Aldrich:

On February 20, 1997, we received a response to our previous FOIA request of October 2, 1996 (FI-160384) for bids submitted on HUD's Note Sales. Although we dispute the withholding of some of the information, i.e. the withholding of unsuccessful bid information, the information we received was extremely helpful. Considering this, we would like to request the same items for the following two note sales which took place after our original request:

- Multifamily Non-Performing Unsubsidized - Midwest: December 14, 1996
- Single Family #4 - January 30, 1997

Specifically, we would like to request a list of all bids submitted for each of the above two note sales that includes, for each bid:

- The identity of the note sale;
- Pools included;
- Amount of bid;
- Name and address of bidder; and
- Whether or not the bid was successful.

Please note that although certain information was declared as exempt from disclosure in your previous response, we are appealing that decision in separate correspondence and we believe we are entitled to all of the above information for both winning and losing bids.
