- All documentation regarding Jack Kerry's contractual relationship that allowed him to work on note sales, including the highly suspect Partially Assisted note sale. This request shall include, but not be limited to, all contracts, contract modifications, task orders, task order modifications, purchase orders, purchase order modifications regarding this work.
- All documentation regarding subcontracting work Jack Kerry has performed for HUD since January, 1995, during this period of time when he was presumably already billing 100% of his time through the SWAT contract he was awarded without competition (which cost HUD approximately \$1.6 million, over four times the initial estimate).
- All documentation regarding Helen Dunlap's role in or knowledge of Jack Kerry entering into subcontracting arrangements during this time period, including communications with Sara Rosen, Monica Sussman, Dewey Ballantine and "liz."
